

Perrysburg Youth Soccer Association Buker and Sipp College Scholarship Information/Application Packet

What is the PYSA Annual Scholarship?

The Perrysburg Youth Soccer Association is a non-profit soccer organization that provides two (2) annual undergraduate scholarships, the Buker Scholarship and Sipp Scholarship. Graduating high school seniors who have participated as a player, referee and/or volunteer with the association are eligible for these scholarships.

Which College/University may the individual attend?

There are no restrictions as to the college/university the applicant may attend. If a student has been accepted to more than one school, they need to inform PYSA of their choice prior to receiving the actual award.

Who is eligible for the PYSA Annual Buker and Sipp College Scholarships?

All applicants must meet the following requirements:

- Applicants must have been involved with PYSA for at least six (6) seasons as a player, referee and/or volunteer.
- Applicants must be within the second semester of their senior year of high school.
- Applicants must plan to continue their education beyond high school and complete this application in its entirety.
- Applicants must be outstanding in character, integrity and leadership.

How does a student apply for the PYSA Annual Buker and Sipp College Scholarships?

- Students may obtain an official Scholarship Information/Application Packet from the Perrysburg High School Guidance Office, the Perrysburg Way Public Library **or online at <http://www.perrysburgsoccer.com/PYSA/forms.htm>**. All applications must be complete and postmarked by **April 19, 2010**.
- In addition to the application packet, a letter of recommendation from a coach, referee coordinator, commissioner or another individual involved in the Perrysburg Soccer Community that may attest to the applicant's character, integrity and leadership is required.

To whom do I send the completed application, and when?

When is the scholarship awarded?

- Scholarships will be awarded in spring during the applicant's senior year of high school. The PYSA Scholarship Committee will review the applications and consider all applicants on the basis of their overall record, the information they provide and the information provided to PYSA on their behalf. Students awarded the scholarship must submit proof of registration at a college/university or other school to the PYSA treasurer. **Awards will be made by the end of May, with notification to follow by the first week of June.**

What criteria will be used in the evaluation process?

- The PYSA Scholarship Committee will observe the following guidelines in reviewing applications.
 1. Service to PYSA (i.e. referee or other volunteer; please specify the number of seasons)
 2. Other non-PYSA soccer activities
 3. Years of playing experience and level of play
 - In PYSA
 - On other clubs/teams
 4. Grade Point Average
 5. ACT/SAT Scores
 6. Extra curricular activities, honors and awards
 7. Essay describing the applicant's participation in PYSA and the impact on their life and future that this participation has had.
 8. Letter of recommendation from member of Perrysburg Soccer Community.
