Soccer Association To Schedule Referee Meeting

The Perrysburg Youth Soccer Association (PYSA) is currently seeking referees for the fall house season. Any boy or girl, who is or will be turning 13 years old by May 29, may apply. Applicants must have a soccer background either in the travel league or extensive house play. Current USSF (travel soccer) referees are encouraged to apply.

Regardless of past experience, in order to be eligible to referee, you must attend a free training/information clinic where PYSA rules and regulations will be explained and demonstrated.

This training/information session is scheduled for Thursday, March 25, from 6:30 p.m. to 8:00 p.m. in the Perrysburg Junior High School cafeteria. Experienced referees, with over 4 seasons of PYSA experience, need only attend from 6:30 p.m. to 7:00 p.m. to turn in availability forms and pick up uniforms.

After you have completed the referee training session, you will be eligible to referee house soccer games.

All those in attendance should bring paper and pencil (or pen) as well as knowledge of their school and sport schedule.

All those in attendance should bring their completed referee availability form, paper and pencil (or pen) as well as knowledge of their school and spring sport schedules.

The season begins Saturday, April 17 and continues thru May 29. No games will be played on May 8. Games are usually played on Saturdays between 8:00 a.m. and 1:00 p.m.

House soccer referees earn from \$10 to \$20 per game and shirts are provided.

Availability forms for all first time referees and anybody needing one are available at www.perrysburgsoccer.com. The website has information on PYSA, PSC and PHS soccer programs.

If you are interested in being a PYSA referee this spring but cannot attend this clinic, you must call Kim Mills, (419) 874-5224, to make special arrangements to pick up your shirt and referee information.

If you cannot attend the meeting, the form must be turned in by Thursday, March 18.

Nobody will be scheduled to referee unless they have attended this mandatory preseason clinic or made other arrangements.
